Parent Code of Conduct

By signing below I hereby agree that:

- 1. I will not force my child to participate in the Twin Cities Junior Roller Derby League.
- 2. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the skaters ahead of any personal desire I may have for my daughter to win.
- 3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability, injury, or illness that may affect the safety of my daughter or the safety of others.
- 4. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, skater, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- 5. I will encourage my daughter to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 6. I will encourage my child to treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- 7. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the rink, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- 8. I will encourage a safe sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol.
- 9. I will refrain from coaching my daughter or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches for my Junior Roller Derby League.

If I fail to abide by the above code of conduct, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include but is not limited to the following:

- (A). Verbal warning by a TCJRD Representative*
- (B). Parental game suspension*
- (C). Parental season dismissal*
- * With written documentation of incident kept on file by TCJRD Representative
